UPDATE: Update your contact information and upload documents

Beginning in April 2023, Medicaid eligibility requirements are being reviewed and redetermination made since the Public Health Emergency caused by COVID has ended. This means that patients who no longer meet the Medicaid eligibility requirements will be disenrolled.

Medicaid Members Should Know:

The patient should receive a letter with a yellow stripe from the Department of Children and Families (DCF) **45 days before** their redetermination date.

- They can update their contact information, upload documents and check their redetermination date with DCF at Myflfamilies.com/Medicaid.
- They can also expect emails and text messages, including a final reminder 10 days before their coverage ends if they don't recertify.
